The last article of this issue, "Effects of the COVID-19 Pandemic on SME Sustainability: Case Study of Car Dealerships in Switzerland", analyzes the impact of the COVID-19 on SME's sustainability of German, French and Italian speaking parts of Switzerland.

We believe that this issue of EJABM appeals to professionals and researchers in the areas of business, economics, and management. Moreover, we believe both firm managers and policy makers can benefit from this issue of EJABM.
